

Cybersecurity: What's Next for Schools?



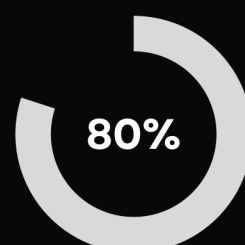

Education sectors sees 29% increase in attacks against education organisations globally.

Australia has recorded a 17% increase in cyber attacks threatening education organisations.

Cybersecurity as Top Threat

Microsoft found that 80% of 8 million enterprise malware alerts came from devices in the education sector.

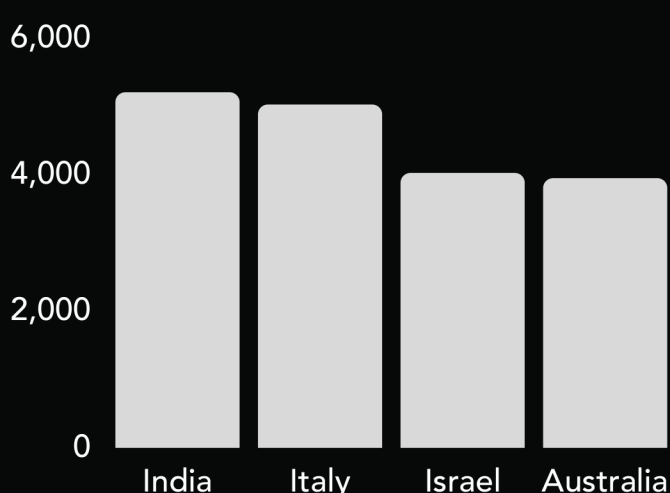


Australian Schools are Increasingly Susceptible

On average, Australian education organisations record 4000 attacks per week in 2021. That is, a 17% increase in cyber attacks on the sector in Q2 2021, compared to Q1 2021.

That leaves us as the 2nd most targeted region in the world.
